Oak Run/AT&T Fiber Optic Project Update

Fellow Association Members,

The Board of Directors wanted to update everyone on the current status of the AT&T Fiber Optic Project that is currently underway in the neighborhood. As stated in a previous letter to the Association membership, the project began at the back of the neighborhood on Oak Brook Drive and is moving forward towards the front portion of the neighborhood. They have also begun the project in the front portion of the neighborhood in recent weeks and will look to meet in the middle. This will be a fairly lengthy project from a time perspective, so please be patient.

The board president has spoken with the OKTEX representative and Regional Manager for the project, Mr. Lyle Alsobrook on a fairly regular basis, and wanted to update you on happenings and progress of the project. Mr. Alsobrook has relayed to us that the streets that have experienced digging and placement of fiber optic conduit have not been forgotten with regards to lawn/property repairs that need to be made. There is a problem with getting the actual fiber optic lines in for them to finish the project, but they must press forward with installing the conduit and round boxes to not stall the project. As soon as they have fiber, the crews will return to pull the lines, install the square boxes and repair any damage to lawns/property that has not already been repaired.
